Wailua Heritage Trail Grant Launched: Thanks to an innovation grant from Kauai County, RCCA is launching its Wailua Heritage Trail project to provide more signage and a new website signifying important cultural and historical places throughout the Wailua River watershed. The end project will feature up to 10 bronze signs mounted on lava rock wall racks or pedestals. The website will feature interpretation of each location. An additional element will be a school field trip program. Delicious Design is managing the sign construction and website, with cultural consultants providing input and overview. The project is expected to be completed next summer.
