Online stats for the 2nd Quarter - compared to the 1st Quarter: RCCA saw modest increases for Adwords, and a modest decrease for website sessions. Comparative data for member links and book now links is no longer available due to a change in the Analytics platform. Instagram showed a significant rise in followers. Social media posts also showed large increase.

Geographic Origin: Hawai'i +16%, California -3%, Texas -23%, Washington -16%, New York -17%, Ranking 6th through 10th place were GA, VA, IL, FL and OH with 799 to 638 visits respectively. The U.S. was off by 9%, Canada up by 18%.

Social Media Activity: Over the past the month, RCCA produced 39 FB and IG posts with two posts boosted (paid) on both FB and IG. Total reach for the month was 8,659 for IG and 17,504 for FB. Total engagement was 5,842.
